

HOW DO I LOG IN TO MY ACCOUNT?



To log in to your ZEGU Virtual Class, enter the following URL into your browser's address bar: <u>eportal.zegu.ac.zw</u> then enter your ZEGU student Reg Number as your username and password.

The e-learning portal is also accessible from both the ZEGU website.

By default, login credentials are set to:


Username: your Student Registration number in lowercase

Password: The barcode number on your student id, which you change at initial login.

Click on the **Log In** button to log in.


HOW DO I FIND MY COURSE?

After logging in, you will find your courses listed below the image in the center of the page. Selecting a course in this list will take you to that course's home page. Please note that you are automatically enrolled for a course after your course registration in the E-Learning portal






You can also view all the courses you are enrolled for by clicking the My Courses tab on the top navigation bar. Select the course you want to access



I FOUND MY COURSE, NOW WHAT DO I DO?


The above image displays a typical course home page. The course's name will be displayed at the top of the page, and a list of the content in the course will be displayed in the **My Courses** area on the page. Most courses will have a Welcome topic which contains your course syllabus, course schedule, instructor contact info, and other course content. These topics are usually separated out by Topics, lessons, or units.

To navigate back to the course home page after viewing the content, you can use the Back button on your browser or the home link highlighted.




HOW DO I LOG OUT?

To log out navigate to the top right corner of the screen and click the down arrow then click logout




HOW DO I TURN IN MY WORK

To hand in your work, click on the activity like Assignment 1 in the picture below




Upon clicking the activity, the page as below will appear. Proceed by clicking on 'Add submission'




To upload your submission, drag it from its location and drop it in the box provided. Alternatively, you can upload the submission by clicking on the 'Add

file' icon as in the picture below. Click 'Save Changes' to complete the submission.




HOW DO I POST IN A DISCUSSION FORUM


To join and post in a discussion, firstly you have to select the course. On the course page, select Forums from the 'This Course' dropdown menu on the top navigation bar.



Clicking on Forums will open the discussions page as below. To open and join a discussion, just click on it.




Finally, you can post in a discussion by clicking on 'Reply' then write the reply in the text area provided and click 'Submit'





HOW DO I BEGIN MY EXAMS OR QUIZZES?

To write an examination, you open your course then open the examination within the topics.



You can alternatively access an examination by clicking 'Events' on the top navigation menu then click 'Go to activity'






BEFORE THE EXAM

Note that the exam is only attempted using the Safe Exam Browser (SEB) browser. The SEB browser is downloadable by clicking the 'Download Safe Exam Browser' available on the exam front page. Run the .exe file to install the browser. The downloading and installation of the SEB browser is not necessary if you have it already installed on your computer. Next you have to run the exam config file and then lastly click 'Launch Safe Exam Browser'

DURING THE EXAM

The exam is only accessible for the period it has been set to last. You can only quit the SEB browser when you're done because an exam usually has only one attempt, once you quit the exam it will not be available for you to write



HOW DO I FIND MY GRADES?

To see your grades, open the Course and then click 'Grades' from the 'This course' tab on the top navigation menu. This will show the view as bellow where you can

see the overview report for all your registered courses as well as a more detailed course report
